



Waste Disposal Checklist

Before You Leave

- Check site hours of operation, including seasonal and holiday schedules. Inclement weather may result in later openings, early closures or all-day closures in extreme events.
- Review the acceptable materials for your specific waste site location.
- Bring your waste disposal card.

Prepare Your Materials

- Separate materials before arrival (household waste, recyclables, scrap metal, etc).
- Keep hazardous materials separate for proper drop-off.
- Ensure containers are empty and free of liquids.
- Remove propane tanks, batteries and fuel from equipment.
- Bundle materials where required.

Load Safely

- Secure and cover all loads to prevent litter from escaping onto roads or waterways.
- Do no overload vehicles or trailers.
- Position materials safely for unloading.

At The Waste Site

- Check in with the site attendant upon arrival.
- Confirm proper disposal locations and whether fees apply.
- Follow all posted signage and attendant instructions.
- Children and pets must remain in vehicles.
- No scavenging or removal of materials from bins.

Fees & Payment

- Some materials may be subject to fees.
- Payment must be made using one of the Township's accepted payment methods.



Waste Disposal Checklist

Reminders for Water Access Waste Sites

- Confirm waste site hours of operation and accepted materials online.
- Bring your Waste Disposal Card.
- Limit of one (1) cubic yard per week per property.
- Separate materials in advance for quick and efficient unloading.
- Ensure all bags and materials are securely tied and covered during boat and vehicle transport.
- Prevent debris from entering the water – help protect Georgian Bay and surrounding waterways.
- Check in with the site attendant to confirm disposal locations and whether fees apply.
- Be prepared to unload your own materials. Staff are available to guide you.
 - If you loaded your boat, please bring someone to assist with unloading.
